THE ONE WORLD PROGRAM

One World Education partners with school districts, charter networks, and individual schools to improve research, writing, and presentation skills for middle and high school students through its signature One World Program. This theme-based learning experience is composed of four stages: **reading comprehension, research, writing, and presentation**. The program increases content knowledge and leverages student ideas and solutions about self-chosen topics to engage learners and advance skills critical for college and career success.

THE ONE WORLD PROGRAM IS DELIVERED IN TWO FORMATS

ONE WORLD CORNERSTONE

DURATION: 4-8 WEEKS

Cornerstones are flexible units that allow 1-2 weeks for each program stage, where students can blend narrative and argumentative writing skills with research to support their own ideas for solutions to age-appropriate, real-world problems.

ONE WORLD CAPSTONE

DURATION: PART OR FULL SEMESTER

The Capstone is a college-prep course that takes a deeper dive into each program stage, preparing students to present their work through a variety of writing and presentation formats while integrating technology.

THE ONE WORLD PROGRAM OFFERS

MATERIALS

CURRICULUM AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT WEBINARS:

Teachers receive a Curriculum Guide with lessons that cover the program's four stages. Approximately 15 Common Core Standards are covered in Cornerstones and 20 in the Capstone. Teachers also have access to professional development webinars to optimize their implementation of the program.

ONE WORLD JOURNALS: Each student receives a journal to guide them through every stage, allowing them to demonstrate their skills through teacher-designed exercises and assessments, ending with a final Argumentative Reflection.



OPTIONAL SERVICES


ON-SITE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT: Empowering preview sessions allow teachers to take on the role of the students and provide time and guidance to differentiate the program to meet the needs of all learners.

EVALUATION: Cornerstones and the Capstone contain pre- and post-assessments to measure growth in a range of Common Core skills. Evaluation is conducted by the World Bank and American University.



A 2016 World Bank evaluation found statistically significant gains in research and writing skills aligned to Common Core State Standards in 93% of the Washington, DC public and charter schools using the One World Program over a four-week period.
